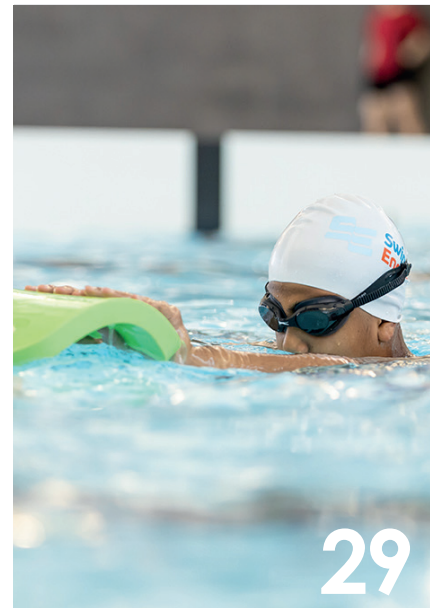

Certikin, and heat pump manufacturer, Global Energy Systems, struck up an ingenious new collaboration this year. And, in the first of its kind, Bicester-based, Central Heat Pumps, recently installed the partnership's first high temperature air source heat pump coupled with a Calorex Variheat, in a domestic pool in Buckinghamshire... with great results!

Global Energy Systems (GES), a British firm with over 50 years of international engineering expertise, specialises in air source heat pump technology. Thanks to this new collaboration, Certikin can now offer those customers buying the Variheat and Delta systems, a high temperature air source heat pump that is a more environmentally conscious alternative heat source than has previously been available.

"With the ability to now offer a 'green' environmental control and primary heat package, this new partnership will enhance, and further consolidate our long-standing, existing relationship with Dantherm, the specialists in heat dehumidification," explains Certikin Marketing Manager, Chris Green.

Designed specifically for the UK climate, the heat pumps outperform gas, oil and electric systems in delivering over 300% efficiency. The capacity of the heat pumps starts from 8.5kW, providing a solution for almost all projects. The models offer remote monitoring with live performance data feedback to GES allowing, if necessary, issues to be fixed remotely.



COMPLEMENTARY STRENGTHS

Putting this new solution through its paces, Bicester-based swimming pool heater specialists, Central Heat Pumps, commissioned the GES heat pump and teamed it with the installation of the Calorex Variheat.

Central Heat Pumps' Paul Casey says: "A client's Calorex unit on his indoor 32 by 16 ft pool gave up the ghost after thirty years of sterling service and was beyond repair. We discussed various options, and my client expressed a desire not to use gas or oil, so an air source heat pump presented itself as the obvious choice. He was keen to try my recommendation of a GES heat pump combined with a Variheat."

The clever, multi-tasking Calorex Variheat Series 3 air handling unit, featuring a PLC touchscreen as standard and endless configuration options, offers the ultimate in flexibility to suit almost every plant room. Total peace of mind is provided as commissioning comes as standard together with a 2-year on-site parts and labour warranty.

With an indoor swimming pool, large volumes of moisture evaporate into the pool hall. Totally self-controlling, the Variheat will remove this moisture and recover energy. In controlling the operation of the heat source and combining it with a highly efficient heat pump dehumidifier, it provides air and water heating, humidity control, ventilation and energy recovery.

By utilising this method, energy costs are kept to a minimum. Typically, for every unit of power that a Variheat consumes, it will convert more than twice this amount to usable heat. The potential energy savings are huge. In fact, compared to traditional heat and ventilation, considerable energy cost saving can be made, and corresponding CO₂ emissions can be dramatically reduced.

The installation took around five days and was very straightforward. "I have an excellent working relationship with Certikin, spanning over 35 years and have seen the company change shape and size enormously," says Paul. "What hasn't changed is its excellent

technical know-how and customer service that we have often come to rely on to get the job done."

"Whether it's a factory made 'bag' liner, or a heavy-duty site applied liner, the range and quality of swimming pool vinyl linings has come on leaps and bounds in recent years," says

Certikin Site Project Manager, Scott Cowan. "The strength and durability of pool vinyl has increased enormously, thanks to the application of improved protective lacquers which, when combined with high quality inks and colourings, improves stain and abrasion resistance, reduces plasticiser migration and helps combat UV degradation."

There's now a huge variety in styles and patterns. The traditional classics have been joined by liners featuring vibrant colours, photographic printing, metallic, pearlescent finishes, and engraved finishes that offer a natural stone look. The finished look can be unique, classical, dramatic, or plain and simple. Each can be combined with a contrasting or complementary anti-slip material for steps and slopes (many of which are an exact match to the main pool pattern).

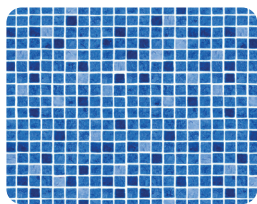
The site applied lining option is increasingly popular with domestic owners due to its durability. Certikin's Infinite On-site Lining range uses a 1.5mm – 2mm three ply product compared to the traditional single ply 0.75mm vinyl used for factory made liners. The service is quick and efficient

– taking around four working days for an average sized domestic hopper pool with steps and there is no curing or standing period. It's suitable for both new and old pools of domestic and commercial size and can accommodate complex shapes, steps, ledges, and pits. The longevity of the product, when compared to thinner linings or paints, is a major advantage, particularly for commercial pools. It comes with a 15-year pro rata warranty, but the life expectancy can be double this in a well-maintained pool.

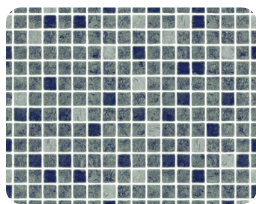
Scott adds: "On-site lining is generally quick, and it also means that the pool trader can continue working on other projects whilst we are working on their behalf."



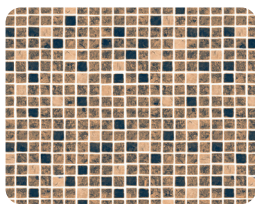

SITE-LINED SWIMMING POOLS SAVE YOU TIME AND MONEY – IF IT'S DONE RIGHT!

As the owner or manager of a growing and increasingly busy pool company, have you ever looked for ways to free up your time while maintaining healthy profit margins? - One such way is to re-evaluate how you line or reline your customers' pools.

The traditional method of using factory-made bag liners has been relied upon for decades and remains an efficient and effective way to line pools. However, this approach ties up your staff for several days, and you bear full responsibility for ensuring a proper fit. You **must** also provide precise site measurements to the liner manufacturer.

In contrast, opting for site-lined pools eliminates many of the challenges associated with ordering and installing pre-tailored liners, freeing up valuable time for more profitable work. There is no need for precise site measurements—the lining company handles this. Additionally, the lining company installs the underlay, conducts the final pool sweeping, and assumes responsibility for the fit and any potential damage during installation. This also removes the costs and

disruptions associated with fitting liners in low temperatures or experiencing delays due to wet weather.

Several key factors must be evaluated when deciding whether your team should undertake the work. Beyond the technical aspects, considerations include the necessary skills, availability of trained personnel, required tools and equipment, time constraints, and material availability. Project complexity, safety regulations, cost-effectiveness, and potential risks should also be assessed. It's also important to consider whether outsourcing might improve efficiency or quality. Evaluating these elements thoroughly will help ensure the job is completed successfully, on time, and within budget.

HERE'S WHAT TO CONSIDER:

FITTING PROCESS:

Flat sheets of material are cut from a roll and shaped before being laid onto the floor. These sheets are joined together using a heat welding process to create a water-tight seal.

A liner lock track or profile, akin to a thin foil lining, is used to fix the liner along the top of the wall face surface. Strips of material with a thicker beading element welded to one edge are shaped on-site to match the wall profile. The walls are hung in place and the floor is then laid and welded to the underlap of the walls. If the floor is sloped or leading into a slope the bottom edge of the wall is fixed and the floor laid from here.

A gap is intentionally left between the bottom of the liner wall section and the pool wall to allow water pressure to evenly tension both elements when the pool is filled. The use of underlay, such as felt for walls and floors, or foam for rough blockwork, depends on the pool shell's surface finish.

JOINING AND SEALING METHODS:

In addition to heat welding using hot air or a hot wedge machine - special situations may call for solvent and PVC adhesives to join materials. Regardless of the method, all joins are sealed with a hand-applied liquid PVC bead along the upper join line.

USE IN BALANCE TANKS:

While 'pre-tailored' liner material may pose fixing challenges in balance tanks due to wall movement, on-site liner material can typically be fixed more securely to the wall.

GUARANTEES:

The guarantee for on-site liners, which can be used in both domestic and some public pools, is generally longer and more comprehensive compared to pre-tailored liners. Guarantees may vary based on usage, so early communication with the liner supplier is crucial.

Liners usually carry a full guarantee in swimming pools with a running temperature of 32°C or less. The guarantee may be reduced for spas or hydrotherapy pools up to 35°C, while temperatures exceeding 35°C can further shorten the liner's life expectancy.

WITH ALL THIS IN MIND, ONE POOL COMPANY OWNER COMMENTED:

"I have considered training my own staff for this type of work, but with only a few lining jobs each year, maintaining their skill level and efficiency would be impossible. Also, I can put them to better use while someone else takes care of it!"

Another issue with performing occasional lining jobs is material batch continuity. Leftover partial rolls of expensive material can significantly cut into profit margins if not used promptly. This challenge is minimal for professional installation companies that consistently move from one job to another, efficiently utilising these materials.

Mastering the skills needed for site lining a swimming pool is critical to success. It takes years of hands-on experience to handle anything beyond a basic rectangular pool. Features such as steps, intricate angles, curves, bowls, ledges, and cover pits demand precise vinyl application, secure welded joints, and a flawless aesthetic—qualities only a highly skilled installer can achieve. Choosing the right installation partner is essential. A reputable installer not only represents your business professionally but also ensures accountability, returning to address any issues if needed.



Because on-site swimming pool lining requires a specialised skill set, it is best left to professionals who perform these tasks routinely throughout the year. Continuous practice and refinement can achieve a true 'expert installation'. It is also beneficial to partner with a company that is a member of the SPATA (Swimming Pool and Allied Trades Association), as SPATA members commit to industry standards and adhere to a Code of Ethics.

THE FINANCIAL BENEFITS OF SITE LINING

The most persuasive arguments in favour of site lining a swimming pool are the financial ones. Take the example of a typical 12' x 24' pool with a hopper figuration. Assuming ordinary conditions and using very approximate costing criteria, the pool company might spend at least two, and probably three days on-site fitting the liner – this would include a final sweep of the pool, clipping and vacuuming the liner into place, cutting out all the fittings and then supervising the filling which would almost always involve subsequent visits over the next day or two.

- Let's assume that the liner will cost £900, and being generous, say that this will have taken up three days on site at a total cost of £400 per day. This gives a theoretical cost of £2,100. If the pool company doubles this, it can charge, say, £4,200.
- In comparison site lining the same pool. The cost of the installed liner would be about £5,000 and involve, at the most, one day on site. So, the total cost would be £5,400.
- Typically, the percentage margin on a site lined pool is less than a liner pool, so by adding 50%, we get to a selling price of £8,100. This gives the pool company a return of £2,700 for one day's work on-site compared to a return of £2,100 for the bag liner with three days on site. Furthermore, the time saved can be put to better and more profitable use elsewhere.

The installation must be executed correctly to capitalise fully on these financial benefits. A poorly installed liner can result in costly return visits and delayed payments, quickly eroding profits. A highly experienced lining partner makes all the difference. Choosing a company with recognised



installation accreditations ensures high-quality work and reduces liability.

Both systems offer cost-effective solutions, but site-lined pools come with significant advantages:

- Extended guarantees
- The lining company assumes responsibility for measurements and fit
- Reduced risk from weather-related delays
- No need for the pool company to be present during installation
- Less liability and higher profits with fewer resources invested

The best way to determine what's right for your business is to make an informed decision. To support pool companies, SPATA offers a Liner Course covering essential topics such as:

- Surveying and preparing the pool
- Installation techniques
- Proper maintenance
- Common pitfalls and how to avoid them

The course also includes a short test to ensure an understanding of key concepts. Training is crucial for recognising the complexities of liner installation and understanding when to rely on specialist liner partners. Even with general knowledge of liner manufacturing and installation, occasional site lining can lead to errors in complex shapes, welded joints, and material management.

When executed correctly, site-lined swimming pools present a more efficient and profitable alternative to pre-tailored liners. This approach

eliminates the need for precise measurements, reduces weather-related delays, and shifts the installation company's responsibility for fit and material use. Professional liner specialists bring the expertise needed to handle intricate pool designs and maintain material consistency, ensuring superior results. Financially, site-lined pools provide higher returns with less on-site labour.

By leveraging professional installation teams, pool companies can streamline operations, enhance efficiency, and boost profitability. This allows them to focus on their core business while leaving liner installation to their skilled expert partners.

Members of BISHTA and SPATA benefit from exclusive access to industry standards, safety guidelines, and supplements, all housed in the dedicated online Members' Hubs. These resources, advocacy initiatives, and enhanced training opportunities enable businesses to implement cutting-edge solutions and deliver exceptional value.

Safety and environmental standards are key pillars of the BSPF's mission. By working closely with WAPSA and EUSA, the Federation ensures that UK businesses align with international regulatory frameworks, while amplifying the industry's global influence. This enables companies to develop products and services that meet the highest standards, fostering trust and innovation.

Recognising the growing interest in water immersion for health and wellbeing, the BSPF is also investigating the potential advantages of cold water immersion, working collaboratively with partners to establish research and development, to substantiate the benefits of cold (and warm) water immersion further. Collaborations are being developed through working with Coventry University and the University of Portsmouth, which aim to provide groundbreaking research on the specific benefits of water leisure products to help futureproof the industry.

With the support of the BSPF, BISHTA has spearheaded an industry subgroup focused on producing comprehensive guidance on cold water immersion. During 2024, the subgroup worked on producing industry guidance for cold water immersion products, with this eagerly anticipated document planned for publication in early 2025, providing valuable insights for industry professionals. This effort is complemented by consumer-friendly cold water immersion factsheets, already available on the BISHTA website.

To highlight the developments and achievements of its members, SPATA and BISHTA host the annual British Pool and Hot Tub Awards, showcasing excellence in construction, design,

installation, retail, hire, service, and innovation. These prestigious awards are the longest-running and most esteemed in our field, offering unparalleled marketing opportunities for members. The awards ceremony takes place during SPATEX hosted by the BSPF at the Wet Leisure Industry Gala Evening. This glamorous evening is the highlight of the industry calendar, bringing together professionals, visionaries, and enthusiasts to honour outstanding achievements and enjoy an unforgettable night of networking and celebration.

For some lucky winners, they will also be shortlisted for the 2025 European Pool and Spa Awards, hosted by EUSA. These awards are held at one of the European shows and in 2025, they will be hosted in Barcelona.

SPATEX is an essential platform, shining a spotlight centre stage on the UK wet leisure industry. As with many exhibitions around the world, SPATEX's primary purpose is to promote trade and offer networking opportunities. 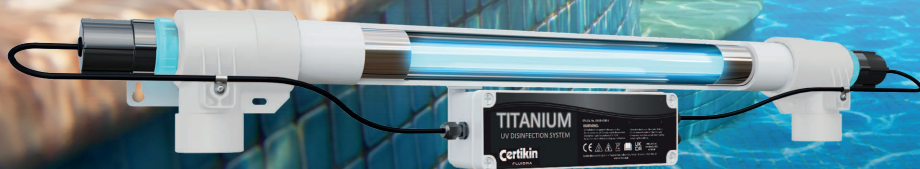

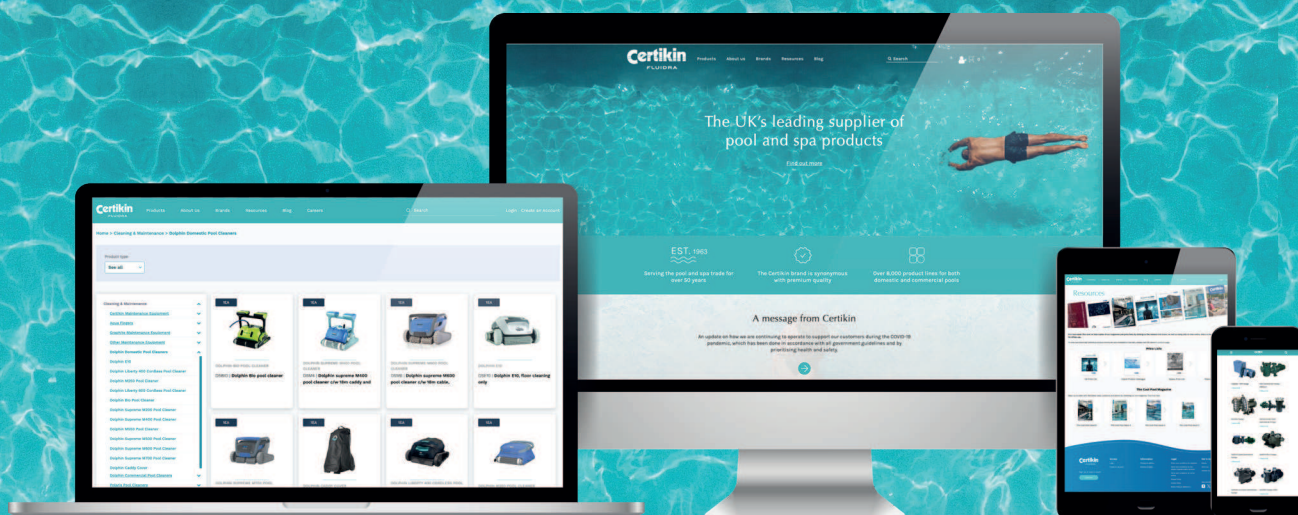

CENTURION LEISURE STRIKES SPATA GOLD AGAIN... WITH A LITTLE HELP FROM CERTIKIN EQUIPMENT

As the UK's largest supplier and manufacturer of water leisure goods, Certikin is renowned for bearing the product hallmark of a long list of award-winning pools. It's therefore little wonder that Certikin's long-standing customer, Centurion Leisure, scooped Gold in the Indoor Residential Freeboard Pools £150,000 and Over category at the 2024 British Pool & Hot Tub Awards (hosted by SPATA and BISHTA) for this eye-catching pool in Ware, Hertfordshire.



No stranger to awards, Hornchurch-based Centurion Leisure has just this February added SPATA National Pool Contractor of the Year 2025 to its crowded trophy cabinet – no mean feat, it is the second year of winning the much-coveted title and the third time in its 57-year history.

"As one of the country's most established pool builders, we have been at the forefront of design and construction in this highly specialised field since 1968," says Centurion Leisure's MD George Clifton. "We have a rare breadth and depth of experience spanning residential and commercial pools."

Instructed to build this concrete, deck-level 10m by 4m pool, with varying depth and an integrated spa and steps, Centurion Leisure chose Certikin, their trusted supplier, to fulfil the brief for "an energy-efficient, stylish installation to complement the airy pool hall."

A Calorex Delta 2 was top of the shopping list. Designed to re-circulate 2,600M³/hr of room air, whilst introducing up to 1,300M³/hr of fresh air, the UK manufactured Delta is a unique multi-functional environmental control system. Featuring touchscreen technology, it takes full control, in the most efficient way possible, of the whole indoor environment and pool water heating.

Totally self-contained, the Delta removes moisture and recovers energy, which is then re-used to heat the pool water and air. By utilising this method of heat recovery, energy costs are kept to a minimum. Typically, for every unit of power that a Calorex heat pump consumes, it will convert 2.4 times this amount to usable heat. The potential energy savings are huge. In fact, compared to traditional heating and ventilation methods, cost savings of over 50% are achievable while corresponding CO₂ emissions can be dramatically reduced by as much as 70%.



Further fulfilling the energy efficiency brief, Centurion installed an automatic Roldeck PVC slatted cover within the deep end wall. The ultimate in energy saving, evaporation control, and durability, the Roldeck is made to measure with the coiling mechanism installed above or below ground or in the pool itself. In an above ground installation, the protective roller cover can be reinforced to create a bench. Touch pad type switch and remote control for easy calibration and operation, a safety lock available for new builds, and the ability to interlock with the air handling system (indoor pools), are just some of its outstanding features.

Roldeck's standard PVC slats are supported by a 5-year pro-rata warranty and come in white, blue, cream, grey, solar, and transparent (with a blue tint). The translucent slats allow under water lighting to shine through. The 24 volt In-Roller Motor system (negating the need for a separate motor pit) features Formula 1 shock absorber seal technology and built-in pressure sensor and a concealed stainless steel motor driven spindle.

Leaving aside the aesthetics, a pool is only as good as its filtration system and, for this, Centurion chose a 1Hp Aquaspeed pump, and Certikin's Blackline 650mm diameter high-rate sand filter complete with side mount multiport valve, pressure gauge and filter media.

Finishing the pool, are Certikin's main drains, skimmers and inlets.

Delighted with his customer's "over the moon" reaction to the finished article, George says:

"I believe we have designed and installed a truly wonderful project. Taking eight months to build, the pool and spa combination, with the shallow/deep end, and the cover 'cave' situated up the wall within the deep end, were quite technically

challenging but well worth the forethought that was put into them.

"When you're working on a project that isn't run of the mill, such as this one, we really appreciate the excellent customer support that Certikin offers and the premium quality of its goods."

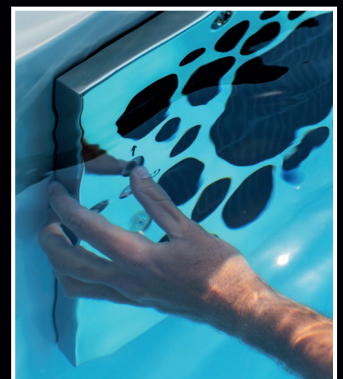

Aquatics GB, Swim England, Scottish Swimming and Swim Wales are joining forces to launch a campaign to raise awareness of the vital importance of school swimming across the country.

As Olympic and Paralympic champions finalise their preparations for the upcoming Aquatics GB Swimming Championships, Aquatics GB and each of the home nations are rallying support from families, aquatics fans and the Government to ensure that every child leaving school is able to enjoy the water safely.

Ensuring children are able to swim is not just about providing health, wellbeing and enjoyment benefits, but ultimately offering them a vital, life-saving skill as well.

Despite swimming being a National Curriculum requirement, only 50% of children from the poorest families in England are leaving primary school able to swim 25m, while only 35% of children in Wales from years 3-6 can swim that distance – a record all-time low for Wales. Meanwhile, a sportscotland review in 2024 found

that the cost of community swimming lessons had risen by 53% over the previous five years.

With 90% of children saying they either like or love swimming* and 74% of children wanting to swim more, we know that children are desperate for the opportunity to swim.

Speaking ahead of the British championships, the chief executives from Aquatics GB, Swim England, Scottish Swimming and Swim Wales said:

"When fans are cheering our Olympic and Paralympic champions on to their incredible performances in the pool, they are watching one step in a journey that began with these athletes learning how to swim as children.

"Those vital water safety skills and a love for being in the water are the most important elements of our sport. For many children, school swimming lessons may be the only opportunity they have to gain those skills and develop that passion.

*Only children in years 1 and 2 were asked this question.

"Across Aquatics GB and our Home Nations partners, we want to shout about the huge value of school swimming and ensure that more is done to improve the chance for every child in the country to benefit. We acknowledge the pressures on schools, so we are keen to work with schools to help improve that picture."

SWIMMING GIVES CHILDREN SO MANY SKILLS

The ongoing National Curriculum review in England presents a great opportunity to put school swimming and water safety at the heart of the PE syllabus, giving it greater priority within schools and raising its importance for school children across the country. Making PE a core subject would be a huge step towards that. In Scotland, meanwhile, there is an ongoing push to lobby Government for additional funding into school swimming.

All of this comes with less than a month to go until the likes of James Guy, Maisie Summers-Newton, Alice Tai and Duncan Scott – all gold medallists from last year's sensational Paris Olympic and Paralympic Games – take to the London Aquatics Centre pool to compete in the biggest domestic swimming event in the UK.

That world-class event also gives us the chance to turn the spotlight on ensuring every child is able to get into the pool, learn water safety skills, enjoy themselves in the water through high quality school swimming lessons and maybe even one day be the next Team GB hero.

Summers-Newton, who has qualified as a teacher alongside training as an elite athlete, said: "Giving children the opportunity to swim throughout their time in school is so important.

"Not only is swimming one of the only sports that can save your life, it gives



the children so many different skills, whether that be physically or socially, that will stay with them forever.

"Seeing first-hand the different children that come into school and the lack of swimming experience that some have, it's shocking to me as an athlete to see how many children can't swim 25m by the time they leave Year 6.

"Hopefully with more promotion and support, schools can provide children with those lessons they need to become confident in the water, while also being able to enjoy it and love the sport like so many of us do."

HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE THE COMPANY CULTURE?

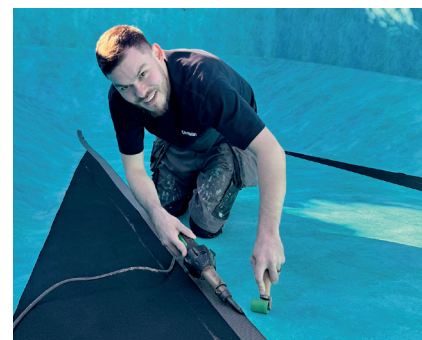
The culture at Certikin feels more like a family than just a team of colleagues. The supportive environment makes the job less stressful, as I can always reach out to someone if I'm having issues.

Josh is a fantastic addition to the IT department – he is hardworking, committed and often stays late after work to finish tasks and complete jobs on a timeframe.

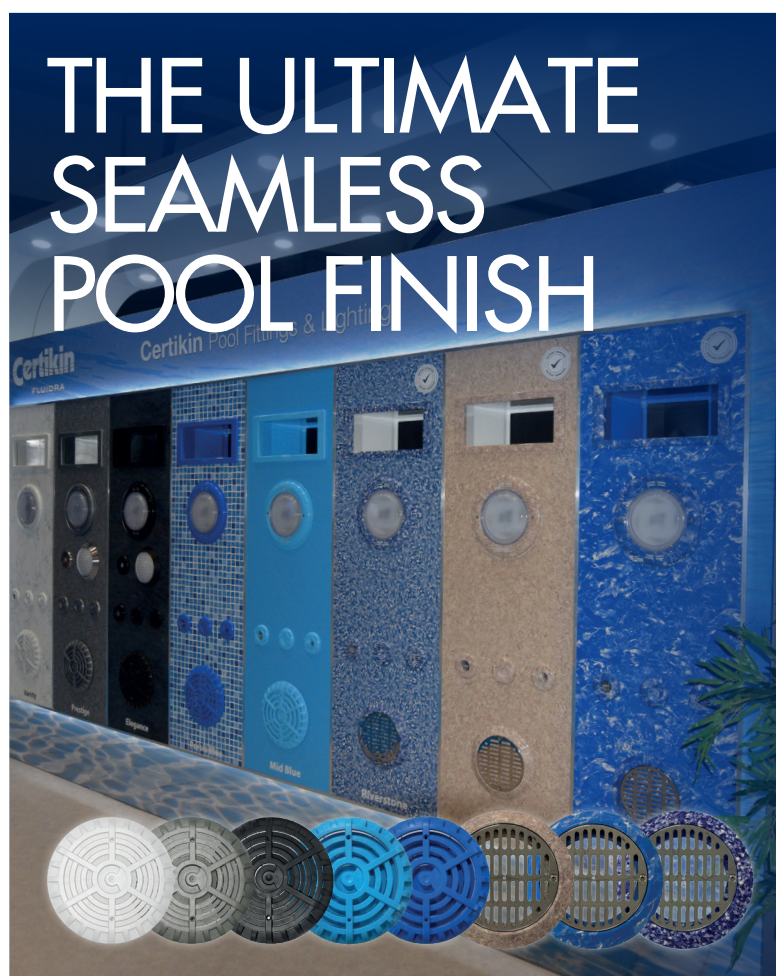
